Thank you! - 2019 Bethlehem on Broad Street (BOBS)

On Saturday, December 7, 11 volunteers from WUMC, along with 26 adults & scouts from WUMC Troops 365 & 752 loaded 202 boxes filled with food and \$10 Kroger gift cards from the PODS to vehicles. Then they delivered the boxes to Broad Street United Methodist Church for the Bethlehem on Broad Street (BOBS) Christmas charity event. These food boxes were then unloaded from the vehicles and stored in the BSUMC gymnasium as part of approximately 725 total boxes which were donated by six United Methodist



churches. The "wall" of food exceeded our expectations and we were humbled with the generous response from our WUMC family. Even though there was a chill in the air, our hearts were warmed by the kindness of our helpers. On Saturday, December 14, another 15 volunteers helped distribute the boxes to needy families in the central Columbus area during the Christmas party at Broad Street UMC.

On behalf of those whose lives were blessed with food for about four days, we thank you for your generosity and caring. Thanks to everyone who helped get the egg boxes, filled a food box, staffed the ministry table and PODS, checked and packed the boxes, shopped for food to complete boxes, loaded and delivered the boxes, and distributed them at the Christmas party. Special thanks to Wendy Raab and the CPC staff, families and children who completed 25 boxes. Thanks also to Weaver Brothers Eggs in Versailles,



Ohio for donating 250 sturdy egg boxes for this ministry and to PODS (Portable on Demand Storage) for donating the PODS to help us securely store the boxes and to make it easier for folks to drop off their donations. Finally, thank you to everyone who donated cash, gift cards and food to help us make this outreach ministry a success!
